**DIRECTIONS FROM NEW JERSEY OR PHILADELPHIA:** Take the Ben Franklin Bridge to the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76 West). Exit at City Avenue (Route 1 South) and go 3 miles to Haverford Road. Turn Right onto Haverford, proceed through one light and make a left on Overbrook Parkway. The Church is on the corner of Haverford & Overbrook. Take first right into parking lot, or park on the street.

**DIRECTIONS FROM THE WESTERN SUBURBS:** Take the Blue Route (I-476) to the exit for Route 3/West Chester Pike (Broomall & Upper Darby). Make a left onto Rte. 3 (going East), go through 6 lights to Manoa Road. Make a left onto Manoa and continue until you reach Haverford Road. The Church will be on the right. Make a Right onto Haverford, a right onto Overbrook Parkway, and park on the street or in the lot next to the Church.
